Release and Indemnity

The terms on which you are allowed to participate in the 2016 Carnival events are set out below. If you do not agree to be bound by these terms, you are prohibited from participating.

1. You are participating in this event at your own risk.
2. The organisers of the event and all persons who are assisting are not liable for injury or damage that you suffer as a consequence of your participation (to the maximum extent that the laws allow), including injury or damage caused by their negligence and you release them from any such liability that they would have to you.
3. You indemnify the organisers of the event and all persons assisting against any claims made against them as a consequence of any injury or damage that you suffer from participating, including injury or damage caused by their negligence.
4. You comply with the directions of the persons conducting the 2016 Carnival at all times.
5. You give permission for photos taken of you on the day to be used for any promotional/educational/marketing/advertising campaign for the City of Griffith.

While we strive to make the parade as fun and creative as possible we do ask that participants consider the safety of themselves and others and abide by our rules.

Legal Requirements and Vehicle Considerations

- Your vehicle must be registered and roadworthy. Unregistered and un-roadworthy vehicles will not be permitted to participate.
- Your driver/s must be appropriately licensed. Some vehicles require a special licence.
- Your driver/s must not have a blood alcohol level over the legal limit. Breath testing may occur.
- There are some legal requirements if your vehicle is between 4.3m and 4.5m high on a public road. If you have a vehicle of this size, you must read the information contained on the following link: <http://www.rms.nsw.gov.au/heavyvehicles/oversizeovermass/overheight.html>

Vehicle Planning Checklist

- Ensure your entry meets the legal requirements and is within the maximum dimensions outlined above.
- Ensure your vehicle is in good condition and suitable for the type of Entry you wish to create
- Ensure the vehicle can support the size, dimensions and weight of the Entry.
- Ensure that the number plates are visible and that the wipers and horn work
- Ensure that there are no decorations or adornings that could fall off and cause injury or damage to traffic.
- Plan for a driver to stay with the vehicle at all times in the Start Area.

Street Parade Rules

1. Above all, have fun!
2. The entry described on your application shall be the only entry that will be allowed into the parade.
3. Each float shall designate one contact person and one alternate contact person and one or both of these people must be on the float on parade day.
4. The designated contact person shall ensure that the float and all float participants comply with the parade and float rules.
5. All entries shall comply with all rules and procedures regarding staging/line up as directed by the 2016 Carnival Marshal.
6. All entries must be able to maintain their speed and position throughout the parade - no faster than walking pace at all times.
7. The distance between floats shall be kept at a safe distance with no overtaking.
8. No objects may be thrown, handed or tossed from any float or by any float participant while participating in the parade.
9. Nothing shall be done to encourage or entice children or parade spectators into the street or the parade route.
10. Possession and/or consumption of alcoholic drinks is prohibited.
11. No participant shall get on or off a moving float.
12. Any entrant not conforming to the regulations and requirements or any entrant refusing to follow instructions of the police or parade marshal may be removed from the parade.
13. Applicants shall obey all applicable laws. All drivers shall be properly licensed for the vehicle they are driving. All required and/or safety devices required for that particular vehicle must be available and operational.
14. The float driver shall have a valid driver's license and vehicle registration papers and present these to the marshal on the day.

Other Considerations:

- Groups wishing to take part without building a float may be a walking unit. Walking units are encouraged to chant, dance, cheer or perform to make the identity of the organisation obvious.
- Any matter of safety not covered in these rules may be reviewed and required to be corrected. Matters considered hazardous to the extent that they may pose a risk to the participants or public shall be corrected. Failure to correct the hazard identified may result in the removal of the float from the parade.
